### What does God want?

It's true that God's requires tithes and offerings according to Malachi. But when you investigate what the word tithe actually means according to the land, language and literature of the Hebrew people's culture and scripture, what churches collect is not tithes. The tithe God authorized in scripture is the tenth part of agricultural products and livestock.

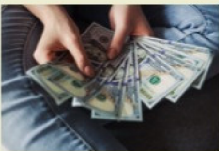
## News Flash

The tithe or tenth is defined as the first tenth animal that comes under the Shepards rod whether it was sheep, goats or bulls. Based on biblical law, whatever is kept watch over, cultivated and grows from the soil (excluding unclean items) is what is tithed to God.

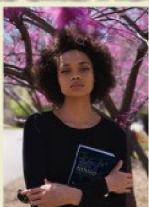
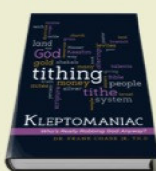
